Overview

Grant Lodge is a 30 bed high care facility in Bacchus Marsh operated by Western Health. Grant Lodge offers 29 permanent beds & one respite bed.

We offer person centred care provided by fully qualified registered nurses, allied health professionals, and diversional therapists.

Prospective residents can organise a visit to Grant Lodge by calling 5367-9639.

These visits are appointment only.

All residents and relatives are encouraged to participate in events occurring within the residential facility and to become part of the Grant Lodge family.

*Two buses are owned by Grant Lodge.
These buses are used to transport residents
to outings at no cost to the resident.*



Features of Grant Lodge

Grant Lodge Features include:

- Central heating throughout
- Air conditioning throughout
- Vinyl flooring areas (non-slip)
- Ramps at all entrances / exits where required
- Designated disabled parking at entrance
- Designated emergency vehicle parking at entrance
- Off street car parking
- Security fencing & gates
- Key pad code security at main entrance
- Security alarmed external doors throughout facility
- The facility is surrounded by secure professionally landscaped garden areas, with sealed walking paths

- Wheelchair accessible buses x 2 for resident outings, seating for 15 plus 3 wheelchairs
- Portable resident phone with headset
- Computer & Skype access for residents
- Hairdressing salon
- Podiatry treatment room
- Physiotherapy room
- Large dining / function room
- Diversional therapy room
- Men's Shed
- Palliative Care room
- Non-smoking site

Bathroom Features

Total of 7 bathrooms with showers.

A bath trolley can be used in 3 bathrooms.

Features in all bathrooms include:

- Non slip vinyl flooring
- Vanity unit with cupboards
- Vanity mirror with storage shelves
- Ceiling exhaust fan with heat lamps
- Hand held shower nozzle
- Stainless steel shelving in shower area
- Drop down handrails at all toilets
- Handrails through all bathrooms
- Shampoo, conditioner & soap dispenser's in all bathroom / toilet areas

Fee Structure

“Grant Lodges Accommodation cost is very competitive against other Aged Care providers.”

Daily Care Fee

As set by the Commonwealth Department of Social Services. The fee is contained within the published documentation “Schedule of Resident Fees and Charges”. This can be viewed on <http://www.health.gov.au>

Currently the Daily Care fee is set at 85% of the standard Australian Aged Pension.

Accommodation Cost

A resident wishing to enter residential aged care will undergo a Centrelink means test (Residents assets and income will be assessed) in order to ascertain the amount that is available to pay for residential aged care in addition to the Daily Care Fee. This amount is known as the Accommodation Cost.

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation cost via a refundable deposit, or a daily payment, or a combination of both. Residents can choose from either of these 3 methods.

A refundable deposit is paid as a lump sum payment.

A daily payment accrues daily paid monthly in advance.

A combination payment, which includes both a partial lump sum and daily payment.

Maximum payments are detailed below; please remember this is means tested.

If the resident is assessed as being unable to pay the maximum amount, then the resident will not be required to pay the maximum amount. For these residents the Accommodation cost will then be assessed against Commonwealth Department of Social Services accommodation cost guidelines.

A representative from Western Health will be in contact with the Resident/Residents representative once the means test has been received from Centrelink.

Accommodation cost will then be advised. This means test needs to be received within 28 days of the resident entering Grant Lodge.

Grant Lodge Maximum Accommodation Costs

Maximum Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) - \$300,000 lump sum

Or

Maximum Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) - approximately \$54.49 per day, depending on Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR)

Or

Each resident has an option of a combination of a RAD and a DAP

e.g. example of combination payment of 50% RAD and 50% DAP

RAD at 50% = \$150,000 lump sum

DAP at 50% = \$27.24 per day
